We urgently need strong nature laws that protect and restore our birds and the places they call home.

The Albanese Government is currently rewriting our national nature laws for the first time in 20 years. This is a once in a generation opportunity to stop the destruction, and to put nature on a path to recovery.

What is needed to achieve strong laws for birds and nature?

- 1. Enact strong and enforced national standards (the rules) that protect and safeguard nature from destruction.
- 2. Create an independent National EPA that will monitor, apply, and enforce these rules and laws.
- 3. Properly fund habitat restoration and threatened species recovery.
